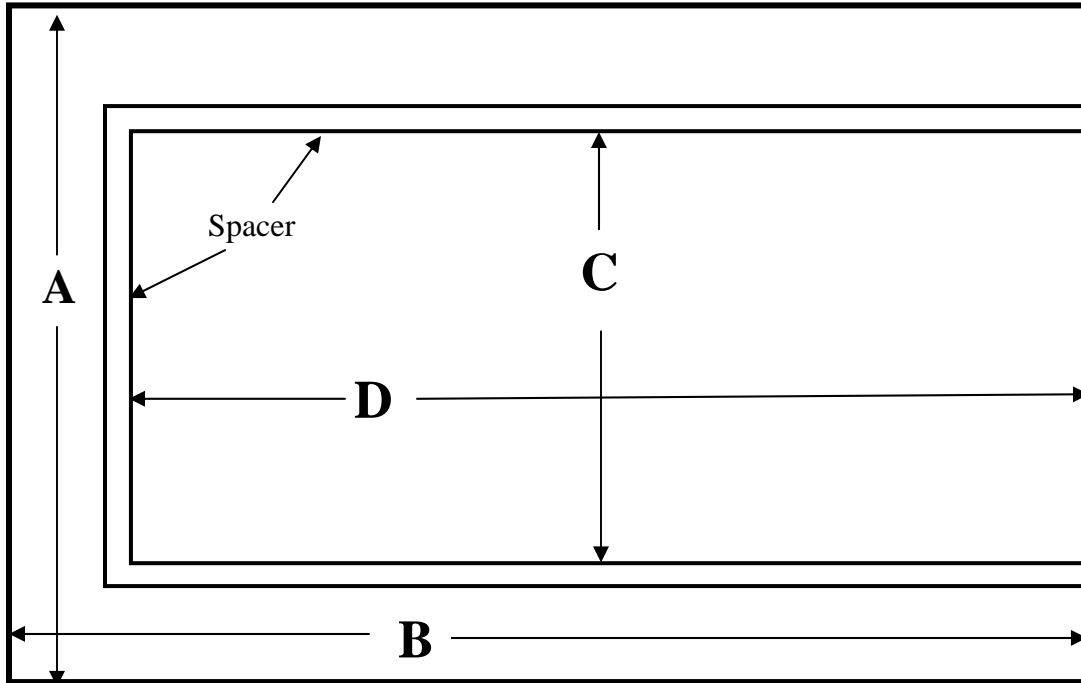


# Reusable Photo Mats

## Mat Backboard



<b>Print Size</b>	<b>8 X 10</b>	<b>11 X 14</b>	<b>12 X 18</b>
<b>Mat Size A</b>	<b>11</b>	<b>16</b>	<b>18</b>
<b>Mat Size B</b>	<b>14</b>	<b>20</b>	<b>24</b>
<b>Paper Size</b>	<b>8 ½ X 11</b>	<b>11 ½ X 14 ½</b>	<b>13 X 19</b>
<b>Spacer C</b>	<b>8 5/8</b>	<b>11 5/8</b>	<b>13 1/8</b>
<b>Spacer D</b>	<b>12 ½</b>	<b>14 ½</b>	<b>21 ½</b>

## Instructions

1. Select proper size mat & backboard for the print size to be matted.
2. Draw lines on backboard for the inside location of spacers.
3. Glue spacers to backboard.
4. Glue mat to backboard.

# Reusable Photo Mats

## Material List:

- Precut mat with backboard.
- Spacer material – edge banding, light cardboard, etc.
- Removable tape – Blue masking tape.
- Old newspaper.
- Adhesive – Elmer’s Craft Bond spray, double faced carpet tape.

## Tools:

- Scissors
- X-acto knife
- Straight edge ruler.
- Self healing cutting board – optional.
