One of the pleasures of being a photographer is sharing your images and experience with others. To that extent, Len Lapka and I had the opportunity, at the request of the Seminole Community Library, to hold a 2-day program on Digital Photography.

The program was for students in the 6th thru 12th grades. The objective was to direct them in ways to take good pictures. Len had a great slide presentation on how lighting and other issues affect the outcome.

I had the section on digital cameras and how the students could use their simple point and shoot cameras to achieve great results. We spent about 45 minutes outside the library taking shots.

The second part of the program was reviewing the images they had taken during the week between classes. Each student submitted two of their best images, which were projected on the screen and then subjected to a simplified critique. Several of the images were then edited in Photoshop.

If you have an opportunity to participate in a similar program, I highly encourage it.

We are being asked by our new members for classes in digital photography, and I think we can combine our President's Shoots into more informative days/evenings. It has been suggested that for each President's Shoot, we form several "teams." The team leader would be experienced in the subject of the shoot and will share information and techniques that will help the newer members.
