Thanks to the efforts of the Florida Camera Club Council (www.F3C.org), our club and others in Florida were alerted to a Feb. 21 draft bill in the Florida Senate which would make it a felony of the first degree to photograph a farm. The F3C's concern with the initial language of this bill was that it could be read to make photographing a farm, even without physically entering it, a felony if permission was not obtained in advance. Obviously this was a poorlyworded draft and could cause serious concerns for nature and landscape photographers in Florida. Fortunately, members of our club and other clubs in Florida alerted their senators and on March 22 the bill was revised to focus on photographing farms when physically on the farm without permission; now a misdemeanor. My personal thanks to our members who wrote their senators on this issue.
