

Memorable photographs capture awards

The Suncoast Camera Club has named its 2008 Image of Year award winners. They are:

- Nick Muskovac for Spoonbill Reflection, Electronic Image of the Year.
- Frank Crommelin for *Spooky*, Monochrome Print of the Year.
- Jim Ickes for *Mother and Baby*, Color Print of the Year.

The club, the oldest camera club in the Tampa Bay area, was founded in 1960 with 15 members.

It now has about 50 members, depending on the time of year.

The club's purpose is to enable members to share their images with other photographers, learn more about photography and enjoy the fellowship of serious photographers.

The club meets at various locations on the first and third Tuesdays of each month. The first Tuesday is Program Night, and the third Tuesday is Evaluation Night.

On Evaluation Night, three club members judge and assign points to the members' digital images, color prints and monochrome prints. The images that collect enough points can be entered into the year-end competition, in which each member can enter up to nine images. Awards are given for different categories of images and level of the photographer. The top photo in each category is Image of the Year.
