

Ombudsman

The Ombudsman shall serve as a Standing Committee member as authorized by Article VI of the Constitution. This person is appointed by the President and is a voting member of the Board of Directors. The duties of this position are briefly listed in Article IV of the By-Laws.

The Ombudsman shall:

Receive written or oral suggestions from the membership.

Bring all complaints and suggestions to the Board for review and decision.
