

Year Book Chairperson

The Year Book Chairperson shall serve as the Special Committee Chairperson as authorized by Article VI of the Constitution. This person is appointed by the President and is a non-voting member of the Board of Directors.

The Year Book Chairperson shall:

Create a Yearbook containing at a minimum: A list of Officers, Standing Committee members, and Special Committee members; competition rules; a list of assigned subjects with definitions; and a membership list.

Obtain a list of paid members from the Treasurer and/or Records Chairperson by a designated deadline to be determined by the Year Book Chairperson.

Revise rules and other pertinent information as enacted by the Board of Directors.

Publish within the budgeted amount and print a sufficient number to cover an anticipated increase in membership.

Distribute printed books to the members and provide the spares for the membership committee.
