

SCC YEAR-END COMPETITION

20. Year-End Competition

- a) Year-end Competition will be held in each Category for each Class.
- b) Entries must have won an Award or HM in a monthly evaluation during the period of January through December inclusive in order to be eligible.
- c) All entries will be judged as General Images.
- d) PRINTS: You may enter three color prints and one monochrome print. The original judging label or a true copy is to be attached to the rear upper left of the mounting material.
- e) ELECTRONIC IMAGING: You may enter three color images and one monochrome image. Entries are to be submitted in the same way that the monthly images are sent. Your color images should be numbered A1, A2, A3; and your monochrome image should be labeled C1. Example: scc-smitj6789-C1-Title.jpg. Do not use "B" for Assigned or add a "C" for critique; all images will be judged as General, and there are no critiques.
- f) The number of awards in each Category shall not exceed the number of entrants in that Category.
- g) Plaques or Certificates will be awarded in the following Categories:

A) PRINTS

- 1) Best Monochrome Print, Class B
- 2) Best Monochrome Print, Class A
- 3) Best Monochrome Print, Class AA
- 4) Monochrome Print of the Year (best of A1, A2 & A3).
- 5) Best Color Print, Class B
- 6) Best Color Print, Class A
- 7) Best Color Print, Class AA
- 8) Color Print of the Year (best of A5, A6 & A7)

B) ELECTRONIC IMAGES

- 1) Best Color Electronic Image, Class B
- 2) Best Color Electronic Image, Class A
- 3) Best Color Electronic Image, Class AA
- 4) Color Electronic Image of the Year (best of B1, B2 & B3)
- 5) Best Monochrome Electronic Image, Class B
- 6) Best Monochrome Electronic Image, Class A
- 7) Best Monochrome Electronic Image, Class AA
- 8) Monochrome Electronic Image of the Year (best of B5, B6 & B7)
